PROJECT OVERVIEW

Monroe County Community School Corporation utilized parking lot space by installing 660kW of solar powered car canopies to generate more power to offset utility costs, while also providing sheltered parking for the school's electric transportation buses. Along with the car canopies, Veregy installed 235kW of roof mounted solar arrays on two separate buildings. Veregy will also install 20 Delta DC City Bus Chargers: Stand-alone, 2-port simultaneous Level 3 50-kW output to charge 40 of Monroe County Community School Corporation's transportation buses. With the installation of this forward-thinking project, Monroe County Community School Corporation displayed their dedication and commitment to becoming a more sustainable facility and a leading example for other school districts nationwide.
