PROJECT OVERVIEW

Since 2009, Groveport Madison Schools has partnered with Veregy (formerly Dynamix Energy Services) to design and implement several turn-key energy related projects. With the availability of federal grants through the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) funds, the district selected Veregy to enhance indoor air quality, improve comfort, and increase energy efficiencies. This Construction Manager at Risk project included the installation of needle point bipolar ionization units in HVAC systems at eleven buildings, LED lighting upgrades in nine buildings, HVAC unit replacements in two buildings and roof installation in one building. In addition, Groveport Madison Schools is currently working with Veregy on a roof replacement project at three of their elementary schools.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- Install needlepoint bipolar ionization units in HVAC systems at 11 buildings (1 High School, 3 Middle Schools, 6 Elementary Schools, and the Administration Building)
- Replace HVAC units at 2 buildings (1 Middle School and 1 Elementary School)
- Upgrade lighting systems to LED at 9 buildings (3 Middle Schools and 6 Elementary Schools)
- Replace the roofing system at 1 Elementary School.
